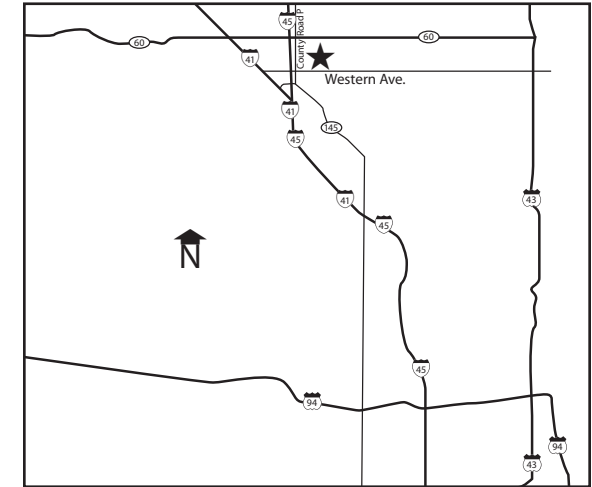

Program Description

Strategies and Methods of Pesticide Applications at Johnson's Nursery—David Thorn, IPM Specialist. Employed with Johnson's Nursery for 5 years, David oversees insecticide, fungicide, and herbicide applications in the nursery fields.

Walking Tour of the Conifer Fields—Scott Johnson, Harvest Manager from 1986 until 2002 and the General Manager of the Jackson Production Facility since 1998. We will see standard evergreens to dwarf and mid-size evergreens. We will also see the upright junipers and arborvitae.

Walking Tour of Shade and Ornamental Trees—Aaron Jambura, Harvest and Inventory Manager, Johnson Nursery, Inc., Jackson location. Aaron has been with Johnson's Nursery, Inc. since graduating in 2001 from UW-Madison's Horticulture program.

Aaron will be giving a walking tour of some of the 400 acres of shade and ornamental trees Johnson's Nursery, Inc. currently has in production. Different attributes of the many species and cultivars we grow will be highlighted.

Plant Propagation Techniques—Michael D. Yanny, Plant Propagator, Johnson's Nursery, Inc. Michael has been the plant propagator at Johnson's Nursery, Inc. in Menomonee Falls, Wisconsin, since 1980. He will be discussing plant propagation techniques used at Johnson's and display several tree and shrub cultivars developed at Johnson's Nursery. Michael has been responsible for developing numerous tree and shrub cultivars, including: Firebird® Crabapple, Leprechaun™ Green Ash, Redwing® Viburnum, Red Feather® Arrowwood Viburnum, Spiced Bouquet™ Viburnum, Spice Island™ Viburnum, Sugar n' Spice™ Viburnum, Sunset™ Buckeye, Technito® Arborvitae, Irish Setter™ Dogwood, Ball O' Fire™ Muscledwood and Firespire™ Muscledwood.
