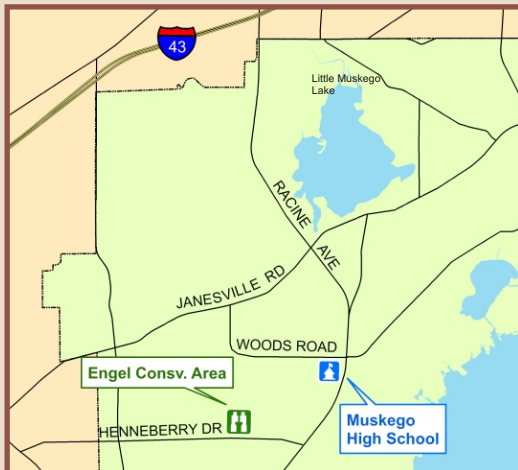

then right (west) on Henneberry Drive
½ mile on the right.

Engel Conservation Area is a 150-acre site managed by the City of Muskego with self-guided nature trails through prairies, wetlands, and woodlands. The property was purchased with assistance from the Wisconsin DNR Stewardship Program and developed with assistance from USDA-NRCS, US Fish & Wildlife Service, Wisconsin Waterfowl Association, Eagle Scouts, and other dedicated citizen volunteers.
