

## **Stress Tested Tree Diversity Options**

### **Description of Presentation**

With over 1300 individual tree survival records and almost 8000 annual growth measurements, the Cambridge Tree Trials present one of the largest non-proprietary datasets known in urban forestry. Join Jay as he shares his latest findings, highlighting the most diverse street and park species selections ever trialed in Wisconsin. Survival and growth rates will be covered along with cultural observations and tips on where to locate these hard-to-find species.

### **Speaker Bio**

Jay Weiss is principal of the Cambridge Tree Project, a non-profit that has donated and established 1000 additional trees throughout the Village of Cambridge since 2006. The Project also sought to greatly expand tree diversity in Cambridge, which has grown to 185 species, the most of any municipality in Wisconsin. He's also been the Cambridge Village Forester in Cambridge since 2010 and serves on the Dane County Tree Board.
